Welcome to the new WEPTO (Westford Elementary PTO). As the new co-presidents, please allow us to introduce ourselves. Kim Koehr has been an SBC (Site Based Coordinator) at Robinson for three years. She is Ethan, Aidan and Avery's mom (currently 2nd grade/1st grade/Pre-School). Kerry Shyjan has been an SBC at Nab for three years. She is Michael, Danielle, & Jack's mom (currently 5th/2nd/2 year old).

The exciting announcement regarding the newly restructured WEPTO – moving away from a big, 6school PTO organization and moving to a smaller, more intimate, school PTO model *will provide schools' the opportunity to make THEIR PTO work better for them.*

 - b. Moderate Gift Wrap/Selling of Consumables
 - c. Labor Intensive (with benefit of social impact) movie nights, community picnics, etc.
- 6. How will the funds be utilized?
 - a. Arts and Education Programs
 - b. Technology Funds
 - c. Funding school project
- 7 What types of Arts & Education Programs do we want?

To keep the newly empowered PTOs focused and motivated in helping their organization with this change, we have outline a theme, objective and goals for the 2015-2016 year.

Theme for 2015-2016: <u>Patience, Togetherness, and Children</u>: We will have patience as we explore what the new structure means for our PTO. We are in this together and will share ideas and experiences so that we can grow together. We will remember that our work is about the children. Remember, a positive change is sometimes a slow change.

Objective for 2015-2016: To help PTOs create a plan for how they want to operate within the new WEPTO structure.
