- Scholastic Book Fair Unclear how much Crisafulli made at this time; Lynn will reach out to Sally to find out. Receiving Scholastic Dollars for profit. Will need to determine spending
- Crisafulli/Seusafulli Reader Generally in March x4 weeks. Will discuss further in February. Some initial thoughts:
  - o Using a Google form rather than paper forms that go home
  - o Rather than drawing names, names are just picked/selected each week
  - o Books would go home with hybrid students and picked up for remote students
- ➤ Tapes for Education (Donelan's) Used to be done at Crisafulli but was stopped at some point. Considering resuming at this time. Similar to Box Tops
  - o Collect receipts from Donelan's; turn them in to receive a credit (cents on a dollar).
